1. Maintenance Facility – Phase Two
2. Bus Shelter at Grant Union High School
3. ADP Hardware (Technology for vehicles and office)
4. Expansion vehicle – 25 passenger – diesel
5. STIF IC grant for the Ontario Route operations
6. IGA with Umatilla County for Umatilla County to purchase services from GCTD for the Pendleton/Walla Walla Run.

Angie updated the committee on changes to the STIF Discretionary reporting versus the STIF Formulary reporting. STIF Discretionary reporting will take place quarterly and will be reported on the APR forms. STIF Formulary will continue to be reported on the SPR forms.

Angie provided a copy of and reviewed with the committee the Technology Assessment for GCTD funded by ODOT and prepared by Full Path Transit Technology and Trillium Solutions.
